CONTRACT/PARENTAL/GUARDIAN CONSENT HOLD HARMLESS AGREEMENT

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

That contestant is not married and has never been married; That contestant has never been pregnant and is not now pregnant, and has not been involved in any act of moral turpitude, that no criminal charges are pending against the contestant, nor has contestant ever done or engaged in any act which is or could be characterized as dishonest, immoral, immodest, indecent, or in bad taste; that contestant is in reasonably good health and can to the best of my knowledge participate fully and without limitations in all pageant activities. If any of the representations and warranties made on any pageant applications and/or documents shall prove if contestant engages in any of the prohibited acts or activities, or otherwise fails to conduct herself in a manner which, in the opinion of the Miss Alabama's Outstanding Teen Pageant, does not uphold and maintain the dignity and of the title she wins, or if the contestant suffers any disability which, in the sole and exclusive judgment of the Alabama Outstanding Teen Pageant, may impair the her ability to perform the duties expected of her as a titleholder, I understand and agree that the Miss Alabama's Outstanding Teen Pageant may, at its exclusive option, terminate contestant's right to participate in the Miss Alabama's Outstanding Teen Pageant, as well as contestants' right to the title may win or has won and all awards and prerequisites thereto, and the successor will receive all of the benefits to contestant would otherwise be entitled. I further agree that if this contestant wins the title of Miss Alabama's Outstanding Teen, she will not make drastic changes to hair color and/or style without the prior approval of the directors and she **MUST** remain drug, alcohol, and tobacco free.

NOTE: Body piercing and/or tattoos are **STRICTLY** prohibited. I understand that the winner of the Miss Alabama's Outstanding Teen title may not participate in another pageant or another title for one year (excluding high school pageants), and she may not compete for the title of Miss Alabama's Outstanding Teen again in the future. I understand that the manner and method of conducting Miss Alabama's Outstanding Pageant shall be the sole discretion of Miss Alabama's Outstanding Teen Scholarship Organization and I further agree that the time, method and manner of judging, the award and supervision of the scholarships shall be within the sole direction of the directors. Miss Alabama's Outstanding Teen Scholarship Pageant and the persons designated to judge the various events in and all matters pertaining to the selection of the winners and shall be final.

I understand that if my child wins Miss Alabama's Outstanding Teen, I agree not to use the specific titles, Miss Alabama's Outstanding Teen, the Miss Alabama Pageant, or the Miss Alabama Pageant, Inc., names for any advertisements or promotions with my child or any commercial endorsement at any time. I understand the official titles are the property of the Miss Alabama America Pageant.

PERSONAL APPEARANCES

I further understand that if my child wins Miss Alabama's Outstanding Teen, that all appearances as a titleholder of this pageant must receive approval from the pageant appearance coordinator. When appearing as Miss Alabama's Outstanding Teen, she will always dress appropriately for the occasion with hair, make-up, nails groomed, and with hosiery. Contestant agrees to work out to maintain good physical appearance and stay abreast of current events and issues. It is my understanding that as a titleholder, my child will be required to wear appropriate pageant clothing with crown at all official appearances. Should my child win Miss Alabama's Outstanding Teen, I understand that I will be required to appear at the Miss Alabama Pageant in June 2007, the Miss Alabama's Outstanding Teen 2008 to relinquish the crown, and represent Alabama at the National Competition TBA as well as other scheduled appearances made on her behalf.

HOLD HARMLESS

I _____ agree to hold harmless the Miss Alabama's Outstanding Teen Scholarship Organization Committee, Miss Alabama Pageant, Inc., the Sylacauga City School System, the pageant officials of any and all responsibility of personal injury, theft, and/or damage of personal property possessed by me during the designated time of the Miss Teen Alabama America Scholarship Program, meetings, workshops, rehearsals, and competitions. It is of my choice that I enter the pageant and with the consent of my parents, guardian, or ward.
